SUMMER TERM 2018

English:

During the summer term we will be looking at narrative stories, persuasive writing and play-scripts.

We will continue to develop the children's understanding of spelling patterns, and work on accurate spelling of the Year 3/4 spelling list. We will also extend grammar and punctuation knowledge.

Maths:

Children will be continuing to develop their mental fluency in maths. We will explore further the four number operations, addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. We will also look at measurement, 2D and 3D shapes, fractions and time.

Science:

Our science topics this term are 'Light' and 'Plants'. Children will have the opportunity to investigate questions through practical means, analyse results and draw conclusions.

French:

The children will be focusing on simple phrases and key vocabulary with a particular focus on their lifestyle.

Computing:

We will be looking at simulations and control programs and how to input commands (coding) to complete tasks using physical devices.

R.E:

We will be learning about the five pillars of Islam and how these affect the every day life of Muslims.

P.E.:

The children will have P.E. on Wednesday and swimming lessons at Leventhorpe:

3K on Tuesday afternoons before half-term.

3PW on Tuesday afternoons after half-term.

We will also have the opportunity to work with specialist sports coaches.
