School safety

For safeguarding and security, when entering the school during the day please ensure you use the intercom and come in via the school side gate only and not through the main car entrance, even if the gates are open at the time. Please only use the main school playground gate entrance in the morning and afternoon when dropping off and collecting children. Under no circumstances should parents enter the school via the Year 6 corridor or classrooms. If you need to enter the school for any reason, or speak to a member of staff, please come to the school office. For the safety of the school, the children and the staff, we need to know who is entering the school premises. As vehicles may be entering or leaving the school at various times of the day as well, it is also important for health and safety reasons to only use the side gate.
