English

We will be consolidating and extending the children's reading and writing skills through a range of narrative genres, poetry, recounts and reports. We will also work on developing the children's knowledge of spelling, punctuation and grammar.

Mathematics

In Mathematics, we will be developing mental arithmetic skills as well as consolidating written methods for division and multiplication. We will also be covering place value, fractions, decimals, percentages and properties of shapes.

Science

Our focus in Science this term will be looking at the circulatory system and nutrition and healthy lifestyles. We will also be investigating electrical circuits. Later this term, we will have our whole school Science and Mathematics week which will include a range of different activities and learning experiences.

Computing

In Computing, the children will develop their use of digital media skills through contributing to blogs and wikis and will continue to consolidate their knowledge of e-safety.

History

Our topic this term is World War Two. We will be focusing on the key events and the impact they had on people's lives during this period.

Art

Pupils will continue to develop their drawing skills using charcoal and graphite for portrait and still life work.

Music

Pupils will have opportunities to create musical pieces using a range of percussion instruments and singing.

R.E

We will be studying Buddhism and drawing comparisons between Buddhism and Christianity.

P.E.

Pupils will continue to develop their skills through gymnastics, dance and invasion games, such as tag rugby and hockey. **Please ensure your child has their PE kit in school every day as we sometimes we have specialist coaching**
