

Pupil Premium Allocation 2016-2017

The Pupil Premium was introduced in April 2011 and is allocated to schools to work with pupils who have been registered for free school meals at any point in the last six years (known as 'Ever 6 FSM') and Children Looked After. The allocation for 2016-17 is £ 1320 per eligible pupil. The estimated pupil premium allocation for 2016-2017 is £44,880.

CPD for staff supporting PPG children particularly those with special educational needs.	£2000	Teaching Assistants effectively deliver interventions so that pupils make good or better progress in targeted areas and within a specific time frame
Lunchtime support for emotional well-being and social skills (Calm Club) Half an hour each day.	£1000	Children able to access learning, particularly in the afternoons. Lessons start promptly and children are engaged in their learning.
Learning mentor for children in Year 6	£3000	Children become more independent in their learning, evaluating and setting their own goals. They will make better progress in lessons
1:1 tuition from teachers 1:2 support in class	£15,000	Addressing gaps in learning for individual pupils. Accelerating progress of pupils according to their individual needs
After school boosters for levels 3 to 6	£2500	All year 6 PP pupils make good or better progress in reading, writing and mathematics
Additional teacher to support wave 1 and wave 2 provision and cover for class teachers to work with PPG children and cover for class while class teacher works with PP children	£22,000	Improved results in mathematics and English
In school interventions for mathematics and writing to support PP children from support teachers	£7000	Accelerated progress of one term for identified children, reducing the attainment gap with other children.
All year groups Pupil Progress meetings (with focus on needs and progress of PP children for all year groups – termly each 2 nd half term	£1200 (12 afternoons' supply)	Continue to ensure there is no gap between PP children and their peers
Breakfast Club and After School Club	£3000	To narrow the gap in the attendance figure and to improve attendance of PPG children so that all have over 95% attendance
Enrichment (trips including residential, visits, music, swimming)	£7500	Improved self-esteem and access to enrichment opportunities
