



Dear Parents/Carers,

Please find attached the home learning suggestions for next week, beginning 4<sup>th</sup> May 2020. All the online materials will be live by Monday morning.

These resources are for guidance over a five day period. We know that everybody's home circumstances are different and you will need to adapt the work set to your own situation. Children should be able to complete the majority of the work independently, although of course you can always support them to extend and challenge.

This week, the adults in school have taken part in a challenge that we hope you will enjoy trying next week. When you are out for your daily exercise ask your child, with your support, to take photos of different signs that you see and then use the letters from the signs (they will need to be cropped) to spell out their name. Children can email the finished picture to their teacher on Purple Mash or send it to [admin@reedings.herts.sch.uk](mailto:admin@reedings.herts.sch.uk). Their pictures will be put onto the pinboard on Purple Mash. The results of the adults' challenge can be seen on the 'Name Challenge' pinboard already. We look forward to seeing the results!
