In each class there is a prize and certificate for the winning tower. A certificate and pencil to keep and a box of chocolates to share with your family for their help and support.

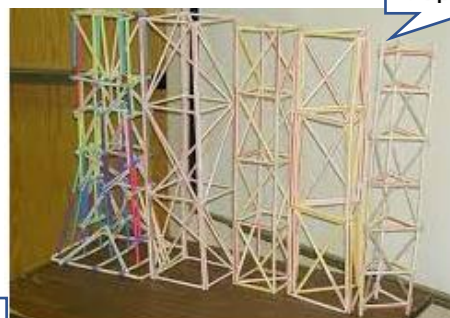
The towers will be judged on how stable, strong and decorative they are.

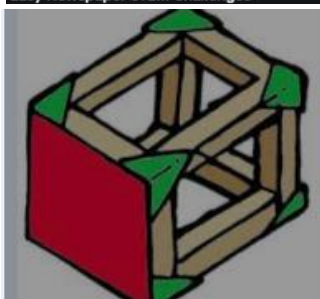

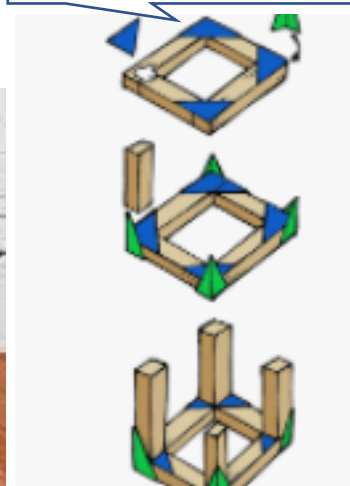

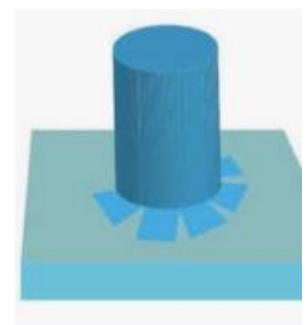
cardboard tubes
