Dear Parents/Carers,

It is our final week next week and I would like to share with you some key timings and plans that may impact on you and your child. Most of these timings are for parents of children in Year 6, but our early finish and 'leaver's arch' plan will have an impact on everyone on the last day.

On Wednesday 21st July from 4pm-6pm Year 6 will be having an after school pizza and ice cream party with games on the school field.

On the last day there will be a leaver's assembly for the parents of Year 6 children. Parents of Year 6 will be invited to stand socially distanced in the playground to listen to their child share some memories of their time at Reedings and receive a gift from the school. A maximum of two people (including siblings) per child will help us ensure social distancing is manageable. The gates will open at **10am** and will remain open for the duration of the assembly. **If it is raining, a 'google meet' link will be sent to your child's google classroom – so please ensure you have their log in details.** A decision will be made on the morning of the assembly and you will receive a text if a 'google meet' link is going to be sent.

School finishes at 2:30pm on Thursday, but parents of Year 6 children only will be invited into school at 2:10pm to watch Year 6 leave through the arch. Children in each year groups will form an arch by holding a piece of string to allow plenty of room for year 6 to pass underneath. Year 6 will then collect their belongings and say their goodbyes, whilst the other year groups return to their classrooms ready to be outside for 2:30pm.

The staff and I are really looking forward to a fun last week with your children and to welcoming Year 6 parents on site for a last goodbye on Thursday.
