Reading, writing and spelling:

Continue to read every day. Read a range of books by different authors and talk about these books with an adult. Send us a review if you read a really good book. We are enjoying reading the recommendations.

You will be set one chapter to read each day along with a set of questions to answer. Make sure you read the text carefully and answer the questions accurately.

BBC Bitesize are releasing a different writing lesson each day. You may want to pick one to complete.

Tuesday: Writing a powerful speech

Wednesday: Structuring a debate/argument

Thursday: Writing a recount
