Activity 2:

Sentence challenge!

- Use 3-4 words (from your planner)
- We have set a writing template **2-do for you on Purple Mash** so that you can type it and send it to us.
- **PLEASE remember to read through your work before you send it so that you can check the punctuation and up-level it if you need to.**



Activity 3:

What happens next? Can you draw a picture in your red book and label it using adverbs and adverbial phrases, and noun phrases?

Challenge:

Maths

- Then, play the currency-matching game we have set as a **2-do on Purple Mash**.
- To practise your number bonds to 100, we would like you to complete the **2-do** that finds change from £1.

It can be real or imaginary). When you are reading the book, you can click on the words that are underlined for a definition..</p>	<p>Science – States of matter</p> <p>https://www.bbc.co.uk/bitesize/topics/zkgg87h/articles/zsgwwxs Watch this video read the information about solids, liquids and gases. There is a sorting game to try at the bottom of the information.</p> <p>Purple Mash – watch the video (click more button to see the extra part of the video and there is some information to read) then complete the activity by describing the characteristics of solids, liquids and gases. (set as a 2do)</p>
<p>Spelling</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Practice Year 3/4 spelling words (in the back of the planner). Look them up in a dictionary and write the definition. Put the spelling words into a sentence. • Purple Mash 2do – Year 3/4 words and prefix dis and mis quizzes 	<p>Music</p> <p>What are your top five favourite songs? Why do you like them? Ask your family the same question and talk about why we like different types of music.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Create a playlist of your family’s favourite songs (or just play them) and have a disco at home! • BBC Bitesize lesson on singing: https://www.bbc.co.uk/bitesize/articles/z7f72sg
<p>History</p> <p>We should now be learning about the Romans...so, let’s go! Over the next few weeks, we want you to decide if the Roman invasion of Britain was a good thing or a bad thing. To do that, we have to be History detectives and find the evidence.</p> <p>This week, we would like you to label the map of Europe set as a 2-Do on Purple Mash. Can you find Italy?</p> <p>Use your skills from Geography to tell us as much as you can about the capital of Italy as it is today.</p> <p>We would like you to research it (and maybe talk to people at home for ideas) and then make a fabulous leaflet (set as a 2-do for you) on Purple Mash. Why is it so popular???</p>	<p>Art – Mosaics</p> <p>Mosaics were a common feature of Roman homes and public buildings. Over the next few weeks we will be looking at mosaics and what they show us about Roman life. The first task is to use the internet to look at some examples of mosaics. You can look at images and find out if there are any famous artists who work with mosaics. Once you have looked at some examples, have a go at designing your own (set as a 2do on Purple Mash – My mosaic 1)</p> <p>RE - Sacred books</p> <p>We will start with a book that is special to you. Please complete in Purple Mash - 2do RE Special Books 1</p> <p>Draw or inset a photo of your special book and answer the questions.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Why is the book special to you? 2. Where do you keep your special book. 3. How do you look after your book? 4. Type a quotation (a bit of writing you like) from your favourite book. 5. Why do you like your quotation?
