



Dear Parents/Carers,

As wonderful as it is to have all of your children back in, we are all fully aware that there may come a time where your child, their year group or indeed the whole school, may need to stay at home. While we hope that this does not happen, we have prepared a plan for children to access learning for three scenarios.

- Scenario 1 is for children awaiting results of a tests, providing they are fit and well themselves.
- Scenario 2 is for individual children who may need to self-isolate for other reasons.
- Scenario 3 is for a whole year group or whole school closure.

We have attached our expectation of children for each of these scenarios as it is really important that children continue to move forward with their learning even if they cannot attend school. This will be subject to review as and when necessary.

F&B are also exploring the use of 'Microsoft 365' and Reedings are looking into 'Google Classrooms' as platforms to share and deliver remote learning in the case of a whole school or year group closure and we will keep you updated once we know more.

Please do notify the office as soon as possible if your child is unable to attend school for one of the above reasons. The office will pick up any phone calls and emails between 8:30am and 4pm Monday-Friday.
