On Thursday 4th March, we will be having a theme day which will be linked to World Book Day. This theme day will again be off timetable and an opportunity for children to take what they need. All the theme-based learning will be on Google Classroom. There will be an introductory video about World Book day and we have created a range of activities for the children to choose between.

Activities:

- **Write a book review about a book your enjoyed**
- **Enjoy listening to stories being read by a range of famous people**
- **Take part in a World Book Day scavenger hunt**
- **Complete the World Book Day Quiz**
- **Get arty and create your favourite book character**

If there is any work from this half term which has not yet been completed, the children can use this day instead to catch up on these activities and then turn them in to their teachers.
