Our home learning expectations are:

Reading – In Year 3, it is expected for children to read for at least **10 minutes every day**. This should give enough time for children to read a sufficient amount each time. We expect this reading to be read aloud to an adult, however some of this time could be spent reading independently. We hope you will take time to discuss the book with your child too, getting them to think about what they have read and maybe make some predictions for what will happen next. Please sign your child's planner each time they read.

Spelling – We will begin by recapping the Year 2 spelling patterns. There will be a new spelling pattern given fortnightly. It is expected that children record their spelling practice daily.

Maths – Home learning for maths will build upon concepts already learned and be set in a variety of ways; sometimes this will include activities on Mathletics, Purple Mash or TT Rockstars.
