English

We will be looking at stories from other cultures, and persuasive and narrative texts. The children will be encouraged to expand and build on their vocabulary as well as developing their understanding of grammar and punctuation. They will be working on improving their fluency and understanding in reading. Presentation and handwriting will continue to be an important focus this term.

Maths

The children will be working on developing methods for applying the four rules of number and continuing to extend their knowledge of shape, measure and data handling. Children will be working on consolidating times tables to 12 x 12.

Science

The Year 4 pupils will be studying the topics of 'Sound' and 'Habitats' and will focus on knowledge and practical investigations.

Computing

This term we will be looking at developing communication and sound through Powerpoint presentations.

R.E.

In R.E. we will be studying the Sikh faith and Christianity, looking at the teachings of both and their associated symbols.

P.E.

Over the term the children will be taking part in swimming and gymnastics.

Geography

Our topic for this term is Europe, and we will be developing our geographical skills and knowledge of countries and cultures around Europe.

Art

In art, we will be looking at famous European artists and developing skills using watercolours.

DT

In DT, we will be learning about and making healthy food from around Europe.

Music

In music, we will be exploring cymatics — the study of making soundwaves visible.
