Activity 1:

Sentence challenge!

Is the girl stirring her tea with a knife **because** she doesn't have a spoon?

This week, we are linking our maths work to BBC Bitesize as it fits with what we want you to learn. The BBC Bitesize website breaks the work into daily lessons that you might find easier to follow. This is what you will need to do:

Monday – Multiply 2-digit numbers by 1-digit numbers

Tuesday – Multiply 3-digit numbers by 1-digit numbers

Wednesday – Divide 2-digit by 1-digit numbers

Thursday – Divide 3-digit by 1-digit numbers
