1. Research a major city on one of the **World rivers**. How is the river used? Make a list of all the ways that the river is used and why it is important to that city. You will then be able to compare how the UK and World rivers are similar and different.

e.g. River Thames vs Nile

Similar – They both run through a capital city.

Different – The Nile crosses 4 countries while the Thames doesn't.
